

Lead Paramedic EMS Instructor

STAT EMS, Inc/Hurley Medical Center Consortium for Paramedic Education is hiring a Full-Time Paramedic Lead Instructor within its Education Department, with primary responsibilities being to plan, schedule and instruct all STAT EMS Paramedic initial education courses.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Must have a high level of confidentiality and sensitivity.
- Must have the ability to maintain interpersonal communications with EMS staff, government agencies, health care providers, community members, volunteers, etc.
- Ability to instruct well to all types of students and to deal with problems that can be presented in training setting.
- Work with minimum supervision/direction to accomplish desired objectives.
- Gather information or research problems/concerns and present facts for action by others within reporting responsibility.
- Exercise good judgment in decisions and be able to work with minimal supervision/direction to accomplish desired objectives.
- Be present at all classes for the education program and/or ensure that a qualified Instructor-Coordinator is present.
- Adhere to all Michigan Department of Consumer and Industry Services requirements for an approved program.
- Arrange for all instructors for the program and ensure all instructors possess the appropriate knowledge and skills.
- Track course and instructor expenses.
- Arrange for all equipment and supplies needed for class.
- Keep the Program Director informed as to the status of the course and provide any feedback and documentation as requested and required.
- Inform the Program Director of any student who fails or is removed from the course and provide written documentation regarding the situation.

Requirements/Preferred:

- Minimum of an Associate's Degree is required, Bachelor's Degree is preferred. (emphasis in Healthcare or EMS-related field is preferable)
- EMS Provider License (MDHHS) at the Paramedic Level is required.
- EMS Instructor Coordinator License at the Paramedic Level is required.
- BLS Instructor is required.
- ACLS Instructor is preferred
- PHTLS Instructor is preferred
- PEPP Instructor is preferred
- PEPP Certification is required.
- Minimum Three (3) years active field experience at the Paramedic Level is required.
- Previous Course Coordination is preferred.
- Previous EMS instructional experience is required.
- Previous general administrative experience is preferred.
